## MONGA recent accomplishments:

- 2009, Missouri General Assembly passed and the Governor signed HB 82 which provides an exemption from Missouri state income tax military retirement pay without regard to the age of the recipients age to be phased in beginning in 2010 and fully phased in in 2016.
- 2009, Missouri General Assembly passed and the Governor signed HB 427 and 861 which provides several important benefits for military members. Please see the Legislative Page on the MONGA website for complete details.

- Consistent modernization and upgrade of all equipment, facilities, and technology capabilities
